A LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

This past Tuesday, we had our first **Parent Advisory Committee** meeting. Thank you to those of you who filled out the PAC interest form this year. If you were not selected to be on the PAC this year, you can reapply next year.

The purpose of our MAC PAC (Parent Advisory Committee) is to advise the Principal and to facilitate communication. Each year, the selection of PAC members is the responsibility of the Principal, and the list of members is reported to the Superintendent. The committee will meet a minimum of 4 times per year and should reflect the school's racial, citizenship, and occupational mix.

We are thankful for this group of PAC members who will help with communication and events this year. It's hard to believe that this group has children that represent all 13 grades at our school!

Performance dates are November 8 and 9 at 7:30 PM in the HS Orchestra Room.

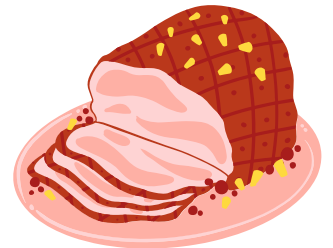
The cast includes ten talented and very funny high school actors. Tickets are on sale in the office for NT\$50 a ticket (non-reserved seats).

AN UPDATE FROM THE HIGH SCHOOL CHAPLAIN

Greetings, parents!

After a typhoon delay, our three-track chapel series got off to a wonderful start today. We have three speakers, all from different backgrounds, all sharing on different topics that are meaningful to them and (we hope) to our students. It is our hope that this experience introduces some variety into our chapel program, and allows students to go deeper on topics that are interesting to them! Just as a reminder, the three series are:

1. What does it mean to be a "disciple" of Jesus? (led by Nathan Keller, around 21 students)
2. Austin Chang will be sharing in Mandarin how he - as a Taiwanese Christian - came to understand and encounter Jesus (about 95 students)
3. Three HS teachers will be sharing about moments in their life where things "did not go according to plan," and how they found hope in the midst of those circumstances (about 40 students)

I would encourage all of you to ask your students what they discussed in chapel today. Below are some pictures from the different sessions:

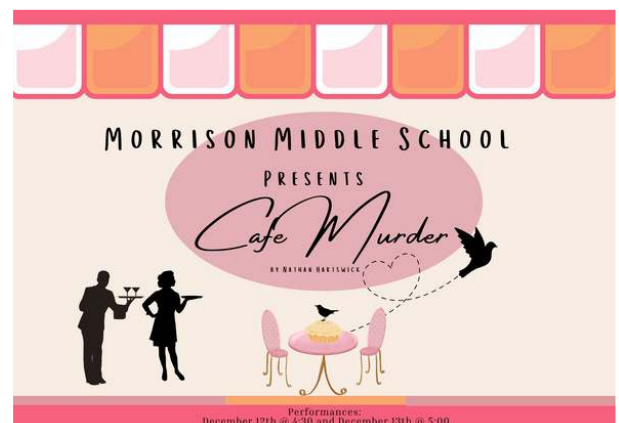
