

#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR HS CHAPLAIN

#### Finding Faith in Morrison Academy High School

Greetings, parents! Chapel finished up today for the semester with some reports and discussion about our Week Without Walls trips, community, and our theme for the year. For this week's Roundup, however, I wanted to change things up and share some thoughts with you about how students are finding faith at Morrison Academy.

Recently I sat down with two high school students who are interested in being baptized, and I had them tell me their stories of how they arrived at this decision. Their stories were what you might expect from any normal teenagers: they told me about conversations with their parents and friends, moments where the question of the meaning or purpose of life became real to them, about things they saw on the internet, about small interactions they had around Morrison over the years. What was most surprising to me, however, was how "normal" their stories were. Neither of them pointed to big spiritual formation events or climactic moments of conversion. Instead, they pointed to the slow, steady, almost invisible inertia of the Holy Spirit working through relationships and their life circumstances to bring them to a place of trust in Jesus. It was the background, the "soil" of Morrison Academy that they were immersed in, that led to spiritual growth.

I share these stories mainly because it is encouraging to hear how God is moving. But also, here at the end of a semester, maybe you need the reminder (as I did) of the bigger picture of God growing his kingdom, which is always going on behind our programs and events and classes and calendars (whether we notice it or not). Morrison Academy is a school - it is buildings, schedules, people and events - but it is also so much more. It can be (and is) a place where people meet Jesus for the first time.

May this Christmas be a blessed time for you and your family!

Alumni games.


